ABOUT FEGENTRI

Organisation

FEGENTRI stands for Fédération Internationale des Gentlemen-Riders et des Cavalières (International Federation of Gentlemen and Lady Riders) and was founded in 1955 by a handful of enthusiastic amateur riders. The founding member countries were France, Germany, Italy, Sweden and Switzerland. Many nations have joined FEGENTRI since then and today the membership consists of 24 different countries.

International Activities of FEGENTRI

The main purpose of FEGENTRI is to promote international races for amateur riders. FEGENTRI organises two World Championships, one confined to gentlemen riders and the other to lady riders, comprising approximately 50 races in different countries around the world. FEGENTRI organizes as well a Championship over jumps for Lady riders and Gentlemen riders.

Competitors in LONGINES FEGENTRI World Championships

The best amateur riders of each member country of FEGENTRI qualify to participate in the WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS and they all feel honoured and privileged to represent their respective countries. They are all “amateurs” and therefore do not receive any fee for riding in races. Amateur riders competing in FEGENTRI World Championship races come from varied backgrounds and have a full time profession. Among competitors one may find bankers, students, policemen and even a vicar! They are all united by a common passion for horseracing.

Members of FEGENTRI

All the member countries of FEGENTRI have their own active association which is responsible for promoting and co-ordinating races and safeguarding the interests of their amateur riders both at home and abroad. The officials of each amateur riders' association represent their nation at the Annual General Assembly of FEGENTRI which is hosted by a different country each year and throughout the season they maintain a close link with the headquarters of FEGENTRI. Associate Members do not have their own amateur club but can organize Fegentri races which count towards the World Championship.

The Longines World Fegentri championships were very successful this year, with 52 races in 16 different countries counting for the championships. Gonzalo Carmena Pineda from Spain is the Gentleman Riders' Longines World Fegentri Champion. Gonzague Cottreau from France came second and Philip Scott Sønsteby from Norway came third.

Thanks to OSASF, the umbrella organisation for all racing authorities in South America, we have reached an agreement to hold a Lady Riders' race on 12 March 2016, the day of the Longines Gran Premio de Latinoamericano, in Rio de Janeiro. This prestigious race is held in different South America countries each year, the Lady Riders race as well. In 2017, it will be held in Valparaiso, Chile, and in 2018 in Maroñas, Uruguay. Our expansion to South America is an exciting challenge, shows that Fegentri is continuing to develop successfully.

Thanks to the substantial efforts of the Board members, Fegentri continued to grow and thrive in 2015. Our values as amateurs are demanding, but also more inspiring than ever for all our members.

Finally, on behalf of all Board members, I would like to express my warmest thanks to our member countries which organised Fegentri races in 2015.

We will all work hard to keep Fegentri's position as a leading institution which continues to adapt to the challenges and opportunities of horse-racing today and tomorrow.

It was a tremendous Longines Fegentri World Championship 2015 with an exciting final in Doha / Qatar.

Gonzalo Pineda Carmena started the season with cautious ride, ending in midfield. But the next race marked the stepping stone for his Titel 'Longines World Fegentri Champion 2015' when he won the first of two legs in Muscat / Oman. On Norway's track in Orevoll he managed to beat local hero Philip Scott into second place, then collecting further important points for the Championship with two second places. It was this constancy that paid off for him in the end.

Gonzalo earned full points with a win in Zürich-Dielsdorf / Switzerland after giving Cominols a very good ride. His final winner of the season was a particularly proud occasion as he could score in front of his home crowd in Sevilla / Spain.

The success of Gonzalo Pineda Carmena is of course a fantastic result for him, and also for his Club AEGRI and President Don Rafael Martinez, as the last Spanish Fegentri World Champion was Diego Sarrabia way back in 2005. Gonzalo has always been a fair rider and hugely popular member of the Fegentri -Team and he acquitted himself well under all circumstances. He is the good representative of Fegentri motto.

The Fegentri Championship for Gentlemen Rider starts traditionally in Cagnes-sur-Mer and Gonzague Cottreau won easily and the same procedure six month later in Deauville. With Kendemai owned by Bertrand Bélinguier he saved the second french Gentlemen Race.

But Gonzague was also able to show his talent abroad. Successful in Muscat / Oman and Strömholm / Sweden he staked the claim for the Title 'Worldchampion 2015'. However, after the race in Sweden his form was a little bit clipped off. Gonzague was placed many times but couldn't get another winner.

Despite of in the category 'Jump' Gonzague will be crowned the World Champion 2015. He participated in six from seven races over the Jumps of these only two counted.

Only in the September Philip Scott won a Fegentri Race. ‘Over the moon’ describes his feeling in the best way after he scores with Moon Ridge in Parx Racing / USA. That has inspired him to do the same four days later. In Delaware Park / USA he was a class of its own with Ebree.

Even if it remains with two wins Philip Scott has safed his third place with 31 points ahead of the fourth placed.

Taking the lead in the Champions Chart after her third start in the Lady Rider Races 2015 the Swedish Power Pack was able to defend this position until the end of the season.

Joséphine began the Longines World Fegentri Championship 2015 successfully, won the second race in Doha / Qatar. Impressive both rides in Budapest / Hungary where none of the other Lady Riders were able to pass her. She took another step towards the Titel 'best Amateur Lady Rider of the World' in Prague / Czech Republic, where she won on I want Dance. She then again showed all her star qualities with an exceptional performance in Deauville / France on Star Dolois which marked her fifth and final winner of the Series.

Throughout the year Josephine displayed strong commitment and a huge determination to win the Championship, and she is a great ambassador for the Idea of the Fegentri. Joséphine will try to defend her crown as she is already nominated to represent Sweden for another year.

FWCN FEGENTRI WORLD CUP OF NATIONS 2015

Nine races were originally planned, but four have unfortunately had to be canceled in the United States of America because of harsh weather.

Note that the 2015 FWCN Fegentri World Cup of Nations circuit inaugurated a stage in Norway, who expediently and successfully filled the unavailability of Great Britain. The Norwegian Club of Amateur Riders (NOARK) showed great commitment and hospitality and at the end of the last stage, in Berlin, its representative Cathrine Fortune clinched victory and allowed the Norwegian team to definitely regain the advantage on France. Its final score stopped at 35 points, topping France at 31 points.

The previous stage (Deauville), also to the credit of Norway (Silja Storen), had brought the Norwegian representation close to France (25 points against 27), who led from the start of the championship with two wins (Lionel Reita at Pisa and Alexandra Rosa at Maisons-Laffitte) and a third place (Oslo).

Behind Norway and France, Italy has accumulated 24 points in total, including 10 points for the victory of Antonio Ferramosca at Oslo and two second places (Pisa and Deauville). The final ranking this year is completed by Germany (4th) and the United States of America (5th).
