FEAGENTRI World Championship for Lady and Gentlemen-riders

07.09.2024 MAGDEBURG, GERMANY - LADY RIDERS

Saturday, September 7th was the occasion for the FEAGENTRI Lady Riders to come and compete for the second race of the season in Magdeburg, Germany, representing the 17th race of the 2024 World Championship for Lady Riders.

All nations were represented for the Lady Riders that weekend between Germany and Turkey, with six nations present in Magdeburg: Germany, Hungary, England, Switzerland, Belgium, Italy. The horse of Giulia Pellegrini, nominated Italian rider, was non-runner.

The handsome SLAY THE DRAGON won for the fourth time in a row in Magdeburg's FEAGENTRI races, ridden by the German nominated rider Janina Boysen, who signs her first FEAGENTRI win in her home country.

The German Amateur Club also treated the ladies to two nice dinners, giving them the opportunity to meet some of the local racing people.

07.09.2024 & 08.09.2024 ISTANBUL, TURKEY - LADY RIDERS

The other group of FEAGENTRI Lady Riders flew off to Istanbul for two races on that weekend and stayed in the capital from Friday to Monday.

On the Saturday, all ladies got to ride at Veliefendi racetrack and Tereza Grbavcicova, Czech nominated lady rider, won the Arabian race on aboard CEBEALP.

Sunday's race, Memorial for Eszter Jeles, saw only three nominated FEAGENTRI riders competing, along with a Turkish

lady rider. This thoroughbred race over 1600 meters was won by Elin Hedman, Swedish nominated rider, on WINTER MY LOVE. She takes the provisional first place in the rankings of the lady riders.

The FEGENTRI lady riders got to experience great hospitality from the Turkish Jockey Club, with lunches and dinners at the races. It was also the occasion for them to visit Istanbul and discover the culture of the country over this full FEGENTRI weekend.

19.09.2024 CHELMSFORD, ENGLAND – GENTLEMEN-RIDERS

The FEGENTRI Gentlemen-Riders rode the 9th race of the

World Championship on Thursday, September 19th at Chelmsford, England. Fletcher Yarham, nominated rider from Great Britain, won the race on SPERIAMO, making it his second success on the FEGENTRI 2024 calendar.

The Amateur Jockeys Association of Great Britain, represented by Sarah Oliver, organised a FEGENTRI dinner after the race in the beautiful countryside hotel where the riders were staying at.

21.09.2024 PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC – MIXED RACE
