FEGENTRI World Championship for Lady Riders

10.05.2025 HALLE, GERMANY

The second race of the 2025 FEGENTRI World Championship for Lady Riders took place on the historic Halle racecourse in Germany, offering an exciting day of competition and camaraderie. Belgian rider Lize Dieteren claimed her first victory of the season, riding ZNOOP DIGGER to an impressive win. With this performance, she officially opens her account in the championship standings, marking a memorable milestone in her FEGENTRI journey.

Beyond the track, the event was also an opportunity for the international lady riders to bond and share experiences. They enjoyed a guided walk through the charming old town of Halle the morning of the race, and ended the day with a relaxed evening meal along the scenic banks of the Saale River.

29.05.2025 MAGDEBURG, GERMANY

The FEGENTRI Lady Riders Series continued with another competitive and well-attended race meeting at the Magdeburg racetrack, where our international lady riders took to the course under ideal racing conditions.

The feature race of the day was once again dominated by SLAY THE DRAGON, who delivered a commanding performance to secure his **fifth consecutive victory** in a FEGENTRI race at this venue, ridden by Tereza Grbavcicova, nominated rider for Czech Republic. Known for his consistency and strength over the Magdeburg course, the horse maintained a steady pace before accelerating in the final stretch, holding off late challengers to cross the line first.

FEGENTRI Gentlemen's League Championship

18.05.2025 AUTEUIL, FRANCE

On the prestigious Grand Steeple-Chase de Paris day at the iconic Auteuil Racecourse, French non-nominated rider Alix Lemaire delivered an impressive performance to secure a well-earned victory aboard MEME PAS KAP in one of the highlight races of the FEGENTRI jumps' calendar.

Representing France, Alix demonstrated both composure and tactical finesse to outpace a competitive international field on a day that celebrates the best of jump racing.

Swedish representative Elliot Öhgren rode a strong race to claim second place, earning 7 valuable points that place him in first position in the FEGENTRI rankings, while Harry Swan, flying the flag for Ireland, secured third place with a solid performance. Fellow French representative Romain Lemièrè crossed the line in fourth, picking up 3 points for his efforts.

Adding to the excitement of the day, Patrick Mullins, renowned amateur jockey, FEGENTRI Board Member and President of the Qualified Riders Association in Ireland, also took part in the race, underscoring the event's prestige and international draw. The race unfolded in front of a vibrant crowd gathered for one of the most celebrated jump racing days in the French calendar. Against the backdrop of the Grand Steeple-Chase de Paris, the FEGENTRI Gentlemen's League race added to the festival atmosphere with thrilling action and an impressive display of amateur talent from across Europe.

A memorable day for all involved, combining elite-level competition with the camaraderie and spirit that define the FEGENTRI experience.
