ABOUT FEGENTRI

FEGENTRI is the International Federation of Gentlemen and Lady Riders. It represents the official connecting body of all international amateur riders' clubs, responsible for the organization of the World Championships, and was founded in 1955 by a handful enthusiastic amateur riders from France, Germany, Italy, Sweden and Switzerland.

It gave the elite amateur riders the ability to connect and interact with the global Racing World. Soon England, Ireland and many more countries joined. More than 25 Racing Nations have since been Member Countries and have organised series of races with high quality participants to find a male and a female World Champion of Flat and Jump Racing, and have been contributing to the FEGENTRI global alumni network.

Core Values are Friendship, Sportsmanship, Intercultural Exchange and Competition between all acting parties. It contains more than 40 Races in 25 countries.

Flat Racing

World Championship for Pony Riders.
Boys and Girls aged 12 to 16 compete in a mixed Championship.
