The Lady Riders once again delivered an inspiring season. Representing Germany, Janina Boysen completed her second consecutive year with FEAGENTRI in exceptional form. Her five international victories in Düsseldorf, a remarkable double at Bro Park in Sweden, Ostende, and Budapest highlighted her strong horsemanship and determination. Awarded the Golden Spur, she crowned a superb season defined by consistency and talent.

Hungary's representative, Judit Dickinson, celebrated the first FEAGENTRI victories of her long and dedicated career, winning in Karlovy Vary, Magdeburg, Most, and Pisa. These achievements also earned her the title of Hungarian Amateur Champion. Her Vermeil Spur recognises a season marked by progress, perseverance, and well-deserved success.

From Sweden, Emelie Gustavsson impressed throughout the season with her excellent riding skills and unwavering determination. She collected numerous second places—Düsseldorf, Clairefontaine, Hamburg, Pisa, and twice at Bro Park on the same day—before securing a well-earned victory in Cologne. Her performances earned her a second consecutive Swedish National Championship title, as well as the local championship at Jägersro, making her Bronze Spur indisputably deserved.

Together, these achievements made 2025 an exceptional Jubilee year for FEAGENTRI. The season was filled with unforgettable racing moments, international camaraderie, and inspiring stories of dedication from riders across the world. Our sincere congratulations go to all riders, national clubs, racetracks, and supporters who contributed to such a brilliant and memorable season.

## FEAGENTRI World Championship for Lady Riders

**DECEMBER 7TH, 2025 – PISA, ITALY – LADY RIDERS**

The final stage of the 2025 FEAGENTRI World Championship for Lady Riders took place on December 7th in Pisa's Ippodromo San Rossore Racetrack in Italy, bringing the international season to a competitive conclusion.

The race saw the Hungarian representative Judit Dickinson secure a well-deserved victory aboard LE BAGARRE, marking her fourth FEAGENTRI success of the year and her first win on San Rossore racecourse. Her performance once again demonstrated her consistency and determination.

This final brought together Lady Riders representing six differ-

Beyond the sporting achievements, the Pisa step also offered a valuable opportunity for the Lady Riders to spend time together off the track. The participants enjoyed discovering the historic city of Pisa and sharing a convivial meal with local members, reinforcing the strong sense of camaraderie, friendship, and cultural exchange that lies at the heart of FEGENTRI.

This final event perfectly reflected the values of FEGENTRI, combining competitive amateur racing with international friendship and memorable shared experiences.

### Last year Fegentri champion, this year leading apprentice

Elin Hedman (22) is one of the most talented riders horse racing in Sweden had for many years. Last year she won the FEGENTRI World Championship for Lady Riders and this year she is the leading apprentice in Sweden.

She had a long and successful background in pony racing

before taking the step to ride thoroughbreds. In May 2022 she had her first ride in a race for amateur riders on a horse trained by former FEGENTRI champion Henrik Engblom. She rode just four races that year. The next year, her first full season, she became national amateur rider champion and the wins have since come at a breakneck pace. At the final race day at Bro Park race course outside Stockholm the 7th of December she secured the national apprentice champion title.
