On behalf of our President and the entire Board, I am delighted to present the fifteenth edition of the FEGENTRI Press Release.

We are now approaching the end of the season, with two additional finals completed this month.

The first, held in Rome (Italy), was the Gentlemen-Riders' Final. Ten years after claiming his first Golden Spur, Gonzalo Pineda Carmena has once again been crowned FEGENTRI World Champion, finishing the season with 58 points. Our warmest congratulations to him and to AEGRI for this remarkable achievement.

Matt Brown (GB) secures a well-deserved Vermeil Spur with 47 points after an excellent season, while Romain Lemière (FRA) takes the Bronze Spur with a close 41 points. Congratulations to all riders and national clubs for an outstanding championship.

The second final was the FEGENTRI Junior Final. After six steps in this third edition of this Championship, Belgium, represented by Mathis Moeykens, wins the 2025 FEGENTRI Junior Championship with 49 points, having impressively won half of this year's Junior races.

SAPUTELLO. The riders enjoyed a memorable weekend, including a tour of the city, a delicious traditional dinner, and an evening visit of the Vatican the day before the race — followed by a festive celebration of the Spurs afterward.
