FEGENTRI World Championship for Lady and Gentlemen-Riders

OCTOBER 5TH, 2025 – BUDAPEST, HUNGARY – LADY RIDERS

The FEGENTRI Lady Riders returned to Kincsem Park in Budapest, Hungary, for the second time this season. Janina Boysen, representing Germany, achieved her fifth FEGENTRI victory of the year, passing the post in first position on DIOS MAKOS, in a field of ten horses. She maintains her position at the top of the Ladies' Championship rankings.

OCTOBER 18TH, 2025 – MOST, CZECH REPUBLIC – MIXED RACE

Lady and Gentlemen Riders came together for a mixed race at Most Racecourse in Czech Republic. Judit Dickinson, representing Hungary, won the race aboard TO TEN METERS, marking her third FEGENTRI victory of the season. Our sincere gratitude goes to the Czech Amateur Club and to Most Racecourse for their kind hospitality and efficient organization of this new step.

The suspense remains high ahead of the Gentlemen's final to be held on November 2nd in Rome. Gonzalo Pineda Carmena from Spain currently leads the standings with 51 points, followed by Matt Brown from Great Britain with 46 points, and Romain Lemièrre from France with 36 points.

FEGENTRI Gentlemen's League Championship

OCTOBER 11TH, 2025 – PARDUBICE, CZECH REPUBLIC – STEEPLECHASE

The fifth leg of the 2025 Gentlemen's League took place on October 11th at the legendary Dostihové závodiště in Pardubice, Czech Republic. It was a fantastic day for the championship, marking a very important moment on the Czech jumps calendar. Charlie Marshall, representing England, claimed victory after an exciting steeplechase race, while Romain Lemièrre of France finished third, Elliot Öhgren of Sweden finished fifth and Barry Walsh of Ireland finished. The day offered an incredible experience for the riders, combining high-level competition with the thrill of participating in one of the country's most significant jumps events.

OCTOBER 18TH, 2025 – WROCLAW, POLAND – HURDLES

The sixth leg of the 2025 FEAGENTRI Gentlemen's League Championship took place on October 18th at Tor Partynice in Wrocław, Poland, marking a historic first for the championship at this beautiful racecourse. It was a remarkable day, offering both a new destination and a unique atmosphere. Elliot Öhgren, representing Sweden, claimed victory, ahead of Charlie Marshall representing England. James Coffey of Ireland finished third while French representative Romain Lemièrè pulled up his horse. For the riders, it was an unforgettable experience, combining the challenge of a top-level hurdles course with the excitement of competing in a unique and welcoming setting. FEAGENTRI warmly thanks the Polish hosts for their hospitality and for helping to create a day that will be remembered by all who participated.

OCTOBER 25TH, 2025 – COMPIÈGNE, FRANCE – STEEPLECHASE

The final stage of the 2025 FEAGENTRI Gentlemen's League Championship took place at Compiègne in France. Florent Guy, previous FEAGENTRI World Champion from France, won this closing race aboard ICI AVRILLY for French trainer Mickael Seror. Ellie Holder, representing Great Britain, finished fifth, Elliot Öhgren eighth, Romain Lemièrè ninth, and Barry Walsh tenth. Following his outstanding season and decisive victory in Wrocław, Elliot Öhgren, representing Sweden, officially secured the
