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FEGENTRI World Championship for Lady Riders

2 JULY 2026 – HAMBURG, GERMANY
The FEGENTRI Lady Riders enjoyed a wonderful stage in Germany during the prestigious Deutsches Derby week at Hamburg Racecourse.
The tenth race of the 2026 FEGENTRI World Championship for Lady Riders was contested over 2,000 metres on turf and attracted a competitive field.
Lize Ghys-Dieteren, riding for Belgium, recorded her second FEGENTRI victory of the season aboard ZNOOP DIGGER, trained and owned by Christian Sprengel. It proved to be a memorable day for Lize, who completed an amazing double by winning both of her races on the card.

5 JULY 2026 – BUDAPEST, HUNGARY
The FEGENTRI Lady Riders were warmly welcomed to Budapest for another memorable Championship stage. The weekend began with a dinner hosted at Kincsem Park on the eve of the races, followed by a guided visit of the beautiful Hungarian capital. On Sunday, the Championship race took place on Hungarian Derby Day at Kincsem Park.
Run over 1,200 metres, the race featured a competitive field of twelve runners representing five nations. Francesca Cecchini, Italian nominated rider, rode EAPHRODITE to victory, narrowly defeating American representative Sophie O'Brien.
The success marked Francesca's second FEGENTRI victory of the season, following her prestigious triumph in the Prix de la Reine Marie-Amélie at Chantilly in June.

12 JULY 2026 – KARLOVY VARY, CZECH REPUBLIC
The FEGENTRI Lady Riders travelled to the beautiful spa town of Karlovy Vary for the twelfth stage of the 2026 World Championship.
The Czech Amateur Club, represented by Pavlina Kasparova, warmly welcomed the riders with a guided tour of the city, followed by a convivial dinner ahead of the race.
German representative Nora Cronauer partnered MANNIX

to victory, claiming her third FEGENTRI success of the season and her first international Championship win. The victory also saw her return to the top of the provisional rankings at the time.
The riders thoroughly enjoyed discovering the unique charm and rich history of Karlovy Vary, making it another memorable stop on the FEGENTRI calendar.

27 JULY 2026 – OSTENDE, BELGIUM
The FEGENTRI Lady Riders travelled to Ostende, Belgium, for the thirteenth stage of the 2026 World Championship, where they shared the race day with the Gentlemen Riders and the Junior Championship.

Run over 2,100 metres, the race attracted a field of five runners. Unfortunately, Hungary's Anna Jeles became a non-runner after her mount BOKEN was withdrawn.
Earine Dubourg, riding for France, won aboard NOUR AYA, securing her second FEGENTRI success of the season after another excellent performance at Bro Park.

FEGENTRI World Championship for Gentlemen-riders

5 JULY 2026 – SAN SEBASTIÁN, SPAIN
The FEGENTRI Gentlemen Riders enjoyed a great stage at the picturesque San Sebastián Racecourse on Spain's northern coast. In a race run over 2,400 metres, Pablo Laborde, Spain's non-nominated rider and President of the Spanish Amateur Club, guided MR ALAN to victory in a field of four runners. The Spanish Amateur Club once again provided excellent hospitality, ensuring a memorable experience for all the participating riders.

23 JULY 2026 – VICHY, FRANCE
The fifth stage of the 2026 FEGENTRI World Championship for Gentlemen-Riders took place at Vichy Racecourse during the town's renowned summer racing week.
Romain Lemièrre, French non-nominated rider who represented his country in last year's Championships, rode J'AURAIS DU to victory for trainer Cédric Boutin.
The race attracted seven runners. Although representatives from three nations had been declared at the declaration stage, the Spanish runner was subsequently withdrawn. In accordance with the FEGENTRI Sporting Regulations, only the foreign rider, Italy's Giacomo Perugini, was therefore eligible to score Championship points on this occasion.

The day concluded with a delightful dinner along the banks of the River Allier, offering the riders a perfect opportunity to enjoy Vichy's warm hospitality.

25 JULY 2026 – MADRID, SPAIN
The sixth stage of the 2026 FEGENTRI World Championship for Gentlemen-Riders took place at Hipódromo de La Zarzuela in Madrid, Spain.

Run over 1,900 meters under the night lights, the race started at 10:45 p.m., offering the riders the unique atmosphere of an evening meeting at one of Spain's most prestigious racecourses.
Alvaro Sainz, riding for Spain, opened his FEGENTRI account for the season with a victory aboard CHENEL, delighting the home crowd.
The evening concluded with a convivial dinner at the racecourse, where riders and organisers enjoyed the vibrant atmosphere of Madrid's popular night racing.

27 JULY 2026 – OSTENDE, BELGIUM
The FEGENTRI Gentlemen Riders also gathered in Ostend for another exciting stage of the 2026 World Championship.
Run over 1,600 metres, the race was won by Mauritius' nominated rider Kenny Roussety aboard QUEEN OF THE SKY, trained and owned by Naomi Asselman. By doing so, Kenny became the first Mauritian amateur rider ever to win a FEGENTRI race, marking an important milestone for Mauritian amateur racing on the international stage.

FEGENTRI Jump Championship

19 JULY 2026 – BAD HARZBURG, GERMANY
The fourth stage of the 2026 FEGENTRI Jump Championship took place at Bad Harzburg, one of Germany's most iconic racecourses.

The riders competed over the demanding 3,550-metre steeplechase course, renowned for its spectacular water crossing, where horses gallop through a small lake—one of the unique features of the Bad Harzburg course.
Ireland's nominated rider Dan Hyde rode INNOVANTE to victory after a skilled performance. The mare had also won the same race in 2025, when she was ridden by French rider Romain Lemièrre.
As always, the German Amateur Club provided a warm welcome, making it another memorable stage of the FEGENTRI Jump Championship.

FEGENTRI Junior Championship

7 JULY 2026 – LONGCHAMP, FRANCE
The second stage of the 2026 FEGENTRI Junior Championship took place at ParisLongchamp Racecourse during one of the popular Thursday evening "Jeux de Longchamp" meetings.
Presented by Poneys au Galop, the race brought together young riders representing six nations in a real international contest.
Great Britain's Lowan Cruise Mills rode MAJOR WILLIAMS to victory, defeating France's Hugo Azoulay, who is also the owner of the winning pony and finished second aboard another mount.

27 JULY 2026 – OSTENDE, BELGIUM
The FEGENTRI Junior Championship continued in Ostend with another international contest featuring the next generation of amateur riders.
Great Britain's Lola Moore guided MINUET to victory, finishing ahead of France's Loris Beaurain aboard KARMA. The shared race day between the Lady Riders, Gentlemen-Riders and Juniors once again highlighted the international spirit and camaraderie that define FEGENTRI.
