We are pleased to announce that Maroñas Racecourse in Uruguay, through OSAF, has officially offered to host the final stage of the 2026 FEGENTRI World Championship for Lady Riders, on the occasion of the Gran Premio Ramírez, Uruguay's most prestigious racing day.

This exciting addition to the calendar will offer our Lady Riders the opportunity to compete on one of South America's most iconic racing days and bring the 2026 Championship to a memorable conclusion.

Cesar Aelbrecht, a Gentleman-rider from Belgium, secured his fifth victory on July 27th, 2026 at Ostende.

Following this achievement, the Belgian Amateur Club expressed its wish for Cesar to represent Belgium in FEGENTRI. As the Championship season is already well underway, he will not participate in the full Championship, but will join the Gentlemen-riders' team whenever an opportunity arises.

As Belgium organised a FEGENTRI Gentlemen-riders' race this season, the nation is eligible to nominate a representative. The Board was pleased to approve this request, welcoming

Cesar to the FEGENTRI Gentlemen-riders' team as an additional participant.

FEGENTRI World Championships for Gentlemen and Lady Riders

1 AUGUST 2026 - LADY RIDERS AND GENTLEMEN-RIDERS - CLAIRE-FONTAINE, FRANCE

The FEGENTRI Lady and Gentlemen Riders enjoyed a wonderful Championship stage in Deauville, hosted by the French Amateur Club.

The weekend began with a delightful evening on the beach at Benerville-sur-Mer, overlooking the sunset, where FEGENTRI riders had the opportunity to meet and mingle with officials and French amateur riders.

The following day, Clairefontaine racecourse hosted two FEGENTRI races, with Lady Riders and Gentlemen Riders competing on the same card. The day began with a photo shoot bringing together our international amateur riders.

The Lady Riders took to the track first for the Prix Prevital, a 1,600 meters flat race. Six riders representing six nations lined up at the start: France, Czech Republic, Sweden, Norway, Belgium and Germany.

Congratulations to Emelie Gustavsson, representing Sweden, who took victory aboard ELUSIVE NELSON, trained by Stéphane Labate.

The Gentlemen-riders then competed over 2,200 meters, with representatives from five nations: France, Spain, Italy, Great Britain and Belgium.

6 AUGUST 2026 - MIXED RACE - LEOPARDSTOWN, IRELAND

The FEGENTRI Gentlemen and Lady Riders travelled to Ireland for another memorable Championship stage, organised by Patrick Mullins, President of the Qualified Riders Association. A successful FEGENTRI Mixed Race was held at Leopardstown Racecourse.

Nine participants lined up for the 3,000-metre race. Unfortunately, the horse of Serena Brotherton (GBR) was declared a non-runner.

14 AUGUST 2026 - LADY RIDERS - LIVORNO, ITALY

The FEGENTRI Lady Riders travelled to the beautiful coastal

town of Livorno for the 16th stage of the World Championship.

The riders were warmly welcomed with a lovely lunch, giving them the opportunity to enjoy some delicious Italian cuisine and spend time together ahead of the evening's racing.

The night race was held under the lights, with six participants representing five nations competing over 1,950 metres.

After a competitive race, Giulia Pellegrini, a non-nominated rider representing Italy, rode to victory aboard her own horse, SEED INVESTOR.

FEGENTRI Jump Championship

15 AUGUST 2026 - PARDUBICE, CZECH REPUBLIC

The fifth stage of the 2026 FEGENTRI Jump Championship took place at Pardubice, one of the Czech Republic's most iconic racecourses.

The FEGENTRI jump riders took on the challenging 3,400-metre hurdle race on this historic track.

Dan Hyde, the nominated rider for Ireland, claimed victory aboard BURSCHI, securing his second win of the season.

As always, the Czech Amateur Club provided a warm and hospitable welcome, making this another memorable stage of the FEGENTRI Jump Championship.
